

The list of project criteria below is meant as a guideline and to be considered, though it is understood that not all projects will fulfil all the criteria. Obviously, social-type projects would not be expected to give a regular financial contribution to the WSA.

Project Criteria:

- Project of a Subud member(s)
- Incorporating activities of one or more Wings
- Enhancing the reputation and standing of Subud to the public
- Intention to make a regular contribution in the future to fund the WSA
- Inspirational and original
- Sustainable
- Meets an unfulfilled need
- Growth potential
- Projects involving more than one member will be preferred
- Projects already operating but looking to expand or develop new areas are eligible
- Support from at least one of the Wings desirable
- Getting Mentor input and advice is advisable and encouraged
- Stating clearly in your proposal what funds are needed and what they will be used for
- What other funding sources you have obtained
- Project has direct benefit to Subud
- Your willingness to share the outcomes of your endeavour in terms of giving an account of how you spent the funds and what the results have been.
